
Although most plays are formatted in Series, we still assign the boks numbers at follows:

$$QB = 1 - TB = 2 - FB = 3 - WB = 4$$


WING BACK MOTION - Since we want to run most, if not all, plays strong and weak, we utilize the WB as a ball carrier just as the TB is used. To get the WB in position to tak a hand off or block at the point of attack, we use what is called" three step motion". The wing is aligned at a 45 degree angle in a one yard by one yard relationship with the TE (or in the slot, the same alignment on the OT) Upon the signal by the QB (foot movement) the wing steps with his inside foot, pivoting on the toe of his outside foot, and takes three steps at an angle that will take him to a position which would put him in the backfield as if aligned as a HB. The ball will be snapped at the time the WB gets to that HB alignment
